

# Flower Brooches or Magnets

(As seen on CTV's Good Living Thursday 6 May 2010)

## Felt Flower:

You will need:

- Felt flowers – two different sizes
- Scrap of co-ordinating fabric
- Button
- Embroidery thread
- Scissors, pins and needle
- Brooch back or magnet



Method:

- Cut a flower out of your scrap fabric piece, a similar shape to your largest felt flower but slightly smaller.
- Layer flowers up, largest on the bottom to smallest on the top, with petals staggered.
- Put a stitch through all layers to hold it all together.
- Place button on top, stitch through all layers and tie off threads on the back
- Glue brooch back onto flower.

## Ribbon Flower:

You will need:

- 0.5m fancy ribbon
- 0.5m contrasting ribbon
- Small scrap of fabric
- Button
- Contrasting thread
- Scissors, pins and needle
- Brooch back or magnet



Method:

- Cut each piece of ribbon into three and make three loops.
- Stagger these loops to make your first flower. (If you are up to it, you can just fold your length of ribbon into these loops without cutting them first). Pin or stitch.
- Repeat with your second lot of ribbon.
- Cut a circle of scrap fabric.
- Layer your two ribbon rosettes with your fabric circle on top. Place button on top and stitch through all layers to hold it all together.
- Glue brooch back onto flower
